Dear customer,

It has been brought to our attention of a potential bug within the RaceCon software in that after P2P is reset the 300s countdown no longer depletes but the system remains operational.

This appears to be effecting versions 2.13 and 2.14 of Racecon where the car is not powered off (Position 0) after the P2P reset.

To ensure all competitors remain in compliance with the regulations and the maximum 300-second limit for the race, all teams are required to power the car off to Position 0 following any P2P reset.

Please note that all race data will be reviewed post-event. Any driver or team found to have exceeded 300 seconds of P2P usage will be reported to the stewards.
